## Day 1

### Bergen

The voyage starts in Bergen, the colorful capital of western Norway, where you can explore the UNESCO-listed Bryggen warehouses, ride the Fløibanen funicular for scenic views, indulge in fresh seafood at the fish market, or wander the lively harbor's charming streets and quays. Bergen is the gateway to the Norwegian fjords and the start of your coastal adventure.

## Day 2

### Florø → Måløy → Torvik → Ålesund → Geiranger<sup>1</sup>/ Hjørundfjorden<sup>2</sup> → Ålesund → Molde

On the morning of the second day, you can greet the Havila Voyages headquarters near Torvik before arriving in Ålesund, known for its art nouveau architecture. During the summer months, you have the option to continue on to the stunning Geirangerfjord, designated as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, to witness its dramatic waterfalls and steep mountain landscapes. During the autumn months, we visit the untouched and majestic Hjørundfjord.



## Day 3

### Kristiansund → Trondheim → Rørvik

It is morning when we dock in the historic city of Trondheim, which was founded over a thousand years ago. The Nidaros Cathedral is the city's major landmark. Furthermore, it is Norway's national shrine and one of the largest cathedrals in northern Europe. After our visit here, the voyage continues towards northern Norway.

## Day 4

### Brønnøysund → Sandnessjøen → Nesna → Ørnes → Bodo → Stamsund → Svolvær

As we journey further north, we'll celebrate crossing the Arctic Circle with a ceremony before exploring the Arctic regions. Witness the Midnight Sun during the summer months or see the Northern Lights illuminate the winter sky. Encounter the awe-inspiring power of the world's strongest tidal current, and spot the majestic sea eagles. In the evenings, you can explore the Lofoten fishing villages, admire the steep mountains, and learn about Viking history and heritage.

## Day 5

### Stokmarknes → Sortland → Risøyhamn → Harstad → Finnsnes → Tromsø → Skjervøy

As we continue through the narrow fjords and wild mountains, we'll arrive in Tromsø, a city with a rich history associated with hunting, fishing, and polar expeditions. Tromsø is also a gateway to the land of the Sami, Norway's indigenous people. Meeting the Sami and learning about their culture, including their unique connection with reindeer, is a truly unforgettable experience.

## Day 6

### Hammerfest → Havøysund → Honningsvåg → Kjollefjord → Mehamn → Berlevåg

This is as far north as you can get — by land and sea. For many, the visit to the North Cape is a highlight and a goal for voyages along the Norwegian Coast. Up here, in the polar landscape, nature is at its harshest and most desolate, but between bare plains and rugged cliffs, people cling on and reap nature's bounty — and you can have a taste of the catch. How about some king crab?

## Day 7

### Båtsfjord → Vardø → Vadsø → Kirkenes

Congratulations, you have now reached the easternmost point of your voyage! The border with Russia is only a few kilometers away, and you may notice that road signs in Kirkenes are written in both Norwegian and Russian. Consider joining one of our excursions to visit the border, or venture to the Snowhotel, where everything is crafted from ice and snow for a unique and memorable experience.

## Day 8

**Mehamn → Kjøllefjord → Honningsvåg → Havøysund → Hammerfest → Øksfjord → Skjervøy → Tromsø**

As we sail west and south, the polar landscape transforms, giving way to towering peaks. In the evening, we'll arrive in Tromsø, known as "The Paris of the North," where you can attend a midnight concert in the Tromsø Cathedral or take a stroll in the stunning Midnight Sun or under the mesmerizing Northern Lights.

## Day 9

**Finnsnes → Harstad → Risøyhamn → Sortland → Stokmarknes → Svolvær → Stamsund**

Next, we'll return to the stunning and picturesque Vesterålen and Lofoten Islands. We will enter the Vesterålen region in the morning, and in the evening, we visit Lofoten. Along the coastline, you'll discover chalky, white sandy beaches alongside charming fishing villages, which still thrive on a vibrant fishing industry. The locals rely on coastal ships for everyday transportation. If the weather permits, we'll venture into the narrow Trollfjord.



## Day 10

**Bodø → Ørnes → Sandnessjøen → Brønnøysund → Rørvik**

At this juncture of our journey, we have ventured so far south that we have left the polar lands behind and crossed the Arctic Circle. However, during winter, you may still witness the Northern Lights illuminating the night sky, while summer brings the magical Midnight Sun. As we sail, we'll pass by numerous small islands, islets, and skerries, including the unique Torghatten mountain, which features a hole in its center. If you're up for it, consider joining us for a hike on the mountain and exploring the cavern.



## Day 11

**Trondheim → Kristiansund → Molde**

We'll sail through the vast Trondheim fjord, flanked by rolling farmland on either side, before reaching the coast and the open sea once more. If you wish to disembark, Kristiansund offers the opportunity for a scenic bus tour along the Atlantic Ocean Road, considered one of the world's most beautiful drives. The road winds along islets and skerries, and after the tour, you can rejoin us in Molde.

## Day 12

**Ålesund → Torvik → Måløy → Florø → Bergen**

On the final day of your journey, we'll take you through a varied coastal landscape that features rugged rocky mountains and an intricate network of straits and waterways between countless islands. The magnificent fjords and glaciers are located further inland. Our voyage concludes in Bergen, but you have the opportunity to join us for one last adventure – a captivating excursion through the city's history, flavors, and breathtaking views. We hope these new memories will be cherished, and we eagerly await the chance to welcome you back on board in the future.

At the ship's highest point, deck nine, you'll find Havblikk Bar & Lounge. Here, you can unwind in comfortable lounge chairs under a glass roof, offering clear views of the Northern Lights, starry nights, or the unique glow of the Midnight Sun.

## Havila Shop Deck 6

Find unique clothing, souvenirs, books, jewellery, and local specialties in the Havila Shop located on deck six, the heart of the ship. In the Havila Shop, you'll find all the essentials for your journey – from toiletries and select pharmacy items to practical clothing for your excursions. ## Jacuzzi Deck 8

Two comfortable saunas are strategically located on deck eight. The men's sauna is on the starboard side, and the women's sauna is on the port side, both conveniently situated near the changing rooms and jacuzzi.



### Fitness Room Deck 7

On deck 7, you'll find two well-equipped fitness rooms. On the starboard side, we have cardio equipment, including treadmills, bikes, and rowing machines, while on the port side, you'll find a variety of strength machines and free weights. Everything is set up for a good and efficient workout. The views from the fitness rooms are nothing short of spectacular, with large windows offering panoramic views of the beautiful landscape we sail past. If you wish to walk or jog while we're in port, we'd be happy to suggest routes for you.

### Onboard Interior

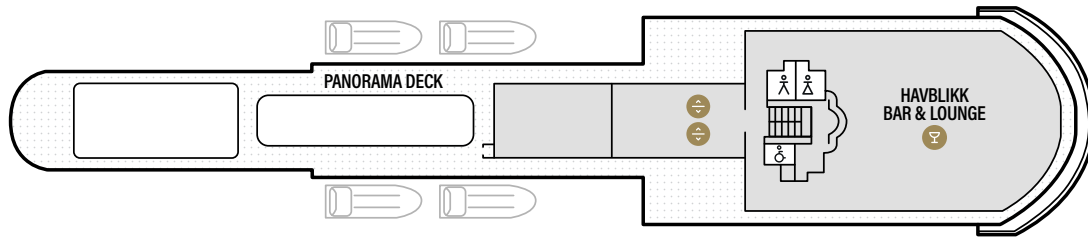

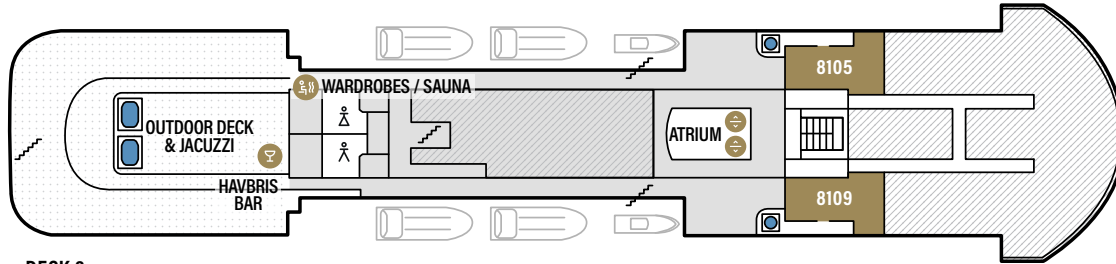
# Deck Plans

### **Winter** November - March

It's a season where silence reigns, only interrupted by the crack of ice or the sound of dog sleds gliding through the snow-clad nature. Explore Arctic culture through encounters with Sami traditions, and experience the connection to nature as winter embraces you with its unique light and enchanting atmosphere.



### **Spring and Summer** April - August

As spring arrives, life awakens along the coast. Waterfalls roar with meltwater, and the coastal towns take on an energetic vibe with blooming flowers and warm sunshine.

Summer brings the long, endless days north of the Arctic Circle. Under the Midnight Sun, you can hike in the mountains or paddle between small islands, with nature around you never sleeping. The sounds of waves and birdsong fill the air, and you can explore the landscape at your own pace.



### **Autumn** September - October

As autumn arrives, nature paints the coast in warm colours. Red and golden leaves frame the deep fjords, and the crisp autumn air is filled with the scent of forest and sea. Excursions offer views of colourful forests and tranquil fjords, while the coastal towns invite you with events that reflect the charm of the season.

The Polar Night brings complete darkness throughout both day and night, occurring only north of the Arctic Circle during the following dates:

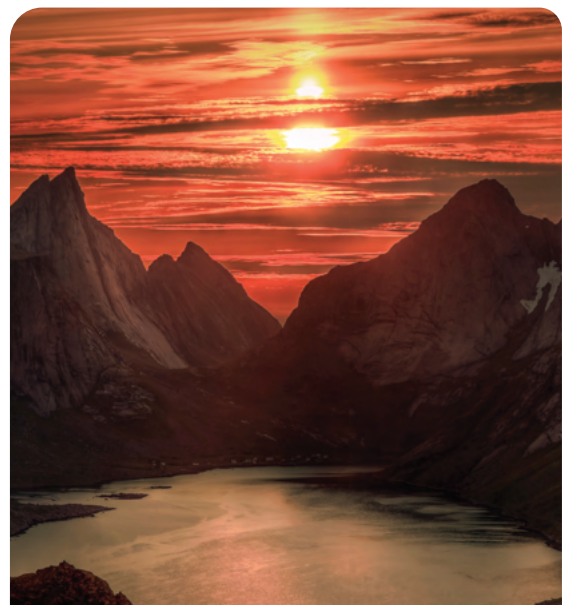

# Experience the Northern Lights

Have you seen the Northern Lights as they are truly meant to be experienced – far from the city's light pollution, under the clear Arctic sky? As night falls, the Aurora Borealis creates nature's most beautiful light show!

## Northern Lights Promise

**1 October - 31 March**

From 1 October to 31 March, we promise the Northern Lights on the Round Voyage Bergen-Kirkenes-Bergen. This means that if the spectacular green lights don't dance across the night sky during your journey within this period, you will receive a free new voyage from Bergen to Kirkenes (Voyage North) or vice versa (Voyage South). The voyage includes an inside cabin and all meals; breakfast, lunch, and dinner.





## When can I see it?

### Season

The Northern Lights season begins with the clear October evenings and continues into the snowy days of winter. January, February, and March keep the magic alive as we witness the gradually returning daylight.

## What is it?

### Science

The Northern Lights occur when electrically charged particles from the sun collide with Earth's atmosphere. Here, they interact with oxygen and nitrogen, releasing energy that we see as light. The colors vary depending on the altitude where these reactions take place, creating everything from green to red and purple hues in the sky.



# Ready for the Coast?

The weather in Norway is as varied as the landscape – here are some tips on how to pack for any season.



## What You Should Pack:

### Clothing

Layering is key to comfort: Start with thin base layers, add warm mid-layers, and top it off with a waterproof outer jacket that can withstand changing weather. Good shoes are also a must – comfortable and weather-resistant shoes or boots that work just as well for city walks as for outdoor adventures. Don't forget a hat, gloves, and scarf – even in summer, the sea breeze can be chilly.

### Equipment

A daypack is perfect for excursions, with room for a water bottle, snacks, and your camera. Pack a reusable water bottle to stay hydrated, and binoculars to spot details in the landscape. Don't forget swimwear – whether you're challenging yourself with a dip in the ice-cold ocean or relaxing in the jacuzzi!

### Extras

Pack comfortable clothes for your time on board, and don't underestimate the importance of sunglasses year-round – they protect against snow glare and the sun's reflection on the waves.

### Documents

Remember to bring your travel documents, valid ID, and ensure your travel insurance is active.
